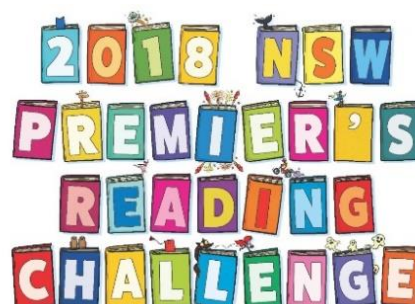

A WORD FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Parents, grandparents and community are encouraged to come along. Everyone, including children are welcome to join us.



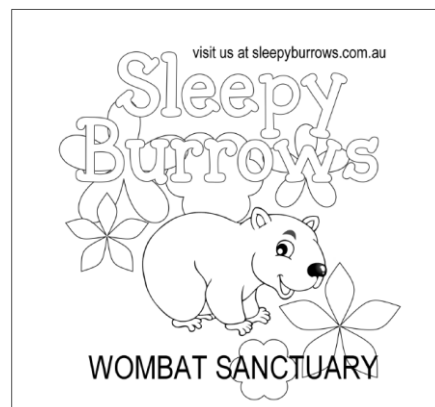
Tarago Show on the 3rd March are having a colouring in competition "Tomato Tourney"
