ONLINE ENROLMENT

We are excited to announce we will be are rolling out the new Online Enrolment System from Monday, 26 October 2020

The Online Enrolment designed System is provide flexibility for our parents to submit an enrolment application online and at the time that The best suits you. application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:

- Enrolments into local schools only
- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents

 Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enrol online. If, however, you do feel comfortable not completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from the front office or can be downloaded from the Department's going to a public school site.

2021 SCHOOL TRAVEL APPLICATIONS



Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now apply online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed schools, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should re-apply or update their details.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on student's grade, system will automatically update student's a entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new eligibility criteria, they will receive an expiry notification via email. Students who have entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to reapply. Applications need to be submitted before 31 December 2020 to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is after 31 submitted December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.
