The big read bus will return to our school on the Wednesday 25th November 2020. Please remember to return any outstanding borrowings, as this will be the last visit for the year.

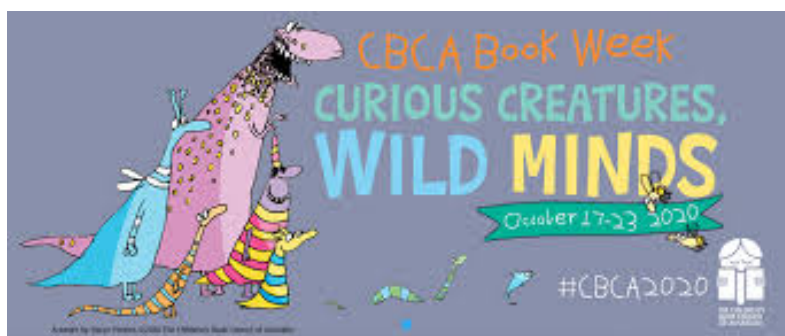

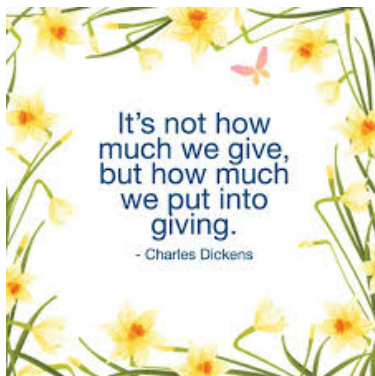

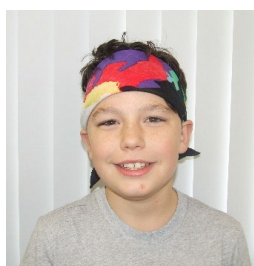


K-2 REPORT
